



Close to Bois de Vincennes, a wonderful area to practise outdoor sports (running, cycling, etc.) or take a walk

# Getting around

## To the school

Walk 5 minutes down Avenue Joffre, then turn left on Avenue de Paris to Saint Mandé Station. Take line 1 to Châtelet (direction La Défense).

Change on to line 4 (direction Mairie de Monrouge) and exit at Odéon. Cross Boulevard Saint Germain, walk down Rue de l'Ancienne Comédie and Rue Dauphine. When you reach n°30, you will find the entrance to Passage Dauphine where our school is located.

## Travel cards

Pass Navigo: monthly or weekly travel card (Paris and suburbs).

## From the airport by public transport

From Charles de Gaulle: Take the RER into the city centre, then line 1 on the Metro (direction Châtelet-Les Halles).

From Orly: Take the orlybus into the city centre, from where you can take the tram to Saint Mandé Residence.

Bayswater airport transfer available on booking.
